

## FAMILY LIVING

he conservatory on Diane Spooner's semi-detached family home had never been a great success – it was old, dilapidated and last year she noticed that the structure was slowly but surely coming away from the back wall of the property.

"It was the full width of the house, my garden is on a slope and the conservatory was literally falling off the back wall," recalls Diane, who works from home as an HR consultant. Needing a reliable contractor to sort the problem out, Diane did her research and looked for companies with positive feedback on the internet.
